Thames Head is usually dry (though a stone tablet marks the spot), but walk a few kilometres and you might see the first waters rise at Lyd Well. The infant Thames then flows through peaceful Cricklade; in Lechlade (home to the statue of Old Father Thames himself) the river starts to swell to

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around 18m across - this is its navigable limit, so it is the place to hire barges for a full Thames cruise.
